Eligibility criteria include:

Queensland residents aged 15 years or older who have left school, and:

- are ineligible for Australian Government employment services or assistance, **or**
- require extra assistance to overcome barriers to learning and employment, **or**
- have accessed Australian Government services for more than six months and remain unemployed.

Training also includes goal setting, job preparation, employability skills, Resumes, interview skills, Police Certificate, Blue Card, First Aid & CPR, two weeks placement experience and help with the cost of public transport.
